### Nearly a third of states have activated the National Guard to assist local police response to unrest

Another night of outrage left stores looted and cars smoldering in many U.S. cities on Sunday as curfews failed to quell violence that replaced peaceful daytime demonstrations over the death of a black man seen on video gasping for breath as a white Minneapolis police officer knelt on his neck.

In the wake of the protests, the National Guard announced that roughly 5,000 guardsmen and airmen have been activated to assist local law enforcement in response to "civil disturbances in 15 states and the District of Columbia." An additional 2,000 members of the Guard are on standby to be activated if needed, and the "situation is fluid," so those numbers are liable to change, reads a statement from the National Guard Bureau.

States that have activated National Guard personnel for the purpose of responding to civil disturbances are Colorado, Georgia, Indiana, Kentucky, Minnesota, North Carolina, Ohio, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Washington, Wisconsin and Washington, D.C.

"The National Guard personnel assigned to these missions are trained, equipped and prepared to assist law enforcement authorities with protecting lives and property of citizens in their state," reads the National Guard statement.

"Guardsmen live in the communities they serve, and are there to protect their neighbor's right to protest peacefully."
